How much are tickets?

Tickets are \$100 each.

How many tickets are available for sale?

There will be 500 tickets available.

Is there a minimum number of tickets that must be sold to win the vehicle?

Yes, 300 tickets must be sold for the vehicle to be raffled off.

What happen if the minimum number of tickets are not sold?

The vehicle is no longer available to be raffled off. The raffle will convert to a 50/50 raffle with the total amount collected (number of tickets sold times \$100) split between the winning ticket and the AFSP-MO Chapter.

How many tickets can I get?

You can only get 50 tickets at a time.

What are the taxes on the vehicle, and what do I have to do if I win it?

The IRS has adopted the position that the \$100 ticket price is not deductible as a charitable donation for Federal income tax purposes. Winner is encouraged to consult a tax professional. The taxes on the vehicle are the responsibility of the winner. The IRS requires American Foundation for Suicide Prevention to issue a 1099. Winner will be issued a 1099 for the stated prize value or MSRP of the prize (whichever is greater) they win. Winner should consult with their CPA as to specifics.

What does my ticket make me eligible for?

Your ticket makes you eligible for the vehicle being offered before deadline passes.

Who is eligible to get tickets and win?

You must be a U.S. legal resident and 18 years of age or older (21 years of age or older in Arizona) to participate and to win any prize. Employees and Board Members of AFSP-MO Chapter and their immediate families are not eligible to participate. Sponsors, media sponsors, their employees and their immediate families also are not eligible to win any prize.

What are the odds of winning?

Odds of winning a prize are dependent on the available tickets for sale. Ticket sales are limited to a specific number. All tickets have an equal chance to win the house.

Do I have to be present to win?

No, you don't have to be present to win or have your ticket confirmation with you. Winners will be announced by name and email address, not ticket number.

How do I know if I won?

We'll call you on the day of the drawing. We'll also send you a Winner Notification Agreement, which will be sent by certified mail, return receipt U.S. Mail to the address provided by that winner at the time of ticket purchase. Each winner will have 7 days from the date of his/her receipt of the Winner Notification Agreement to accept the prize by executing and returning the Winner Notification Agreement and accept the prize "as is".

May I claim my ticket as a tax deduction?

"KIA CARES" Car Raffle tickets are not tax-deductible. When you purchase a ticket, you're signing up for a chance to win in a raffle.

How much of the proceeds go to AFSP-MO Chapter?

All the net proceeds go directly to American Foundation for Suicide Prevention with 50% staying with the Missouri Chapter and its mission: Saving Lives and Bringing Hope to Those Affected by Suicide®
