DESCRIPTION OF ROUTE VOLUNTEER DUTIES:

Rest Stops: Located at every 10-15 miles on our 25 and 62 mile route options. Keep our cyclists hydrated and well fed with nutritious eats. Great opportunity for groups!

SAG: Drives or navigates a minivan with cargo room, picking up riders in need (and their bikes!). Patrols between Rest Stops and is dispatched by our staff. **Must be 25+ and have a valid driver's license.**

Bike Caboose: Trails the last rider on each of our (2) routes, serves as a master motivator, and is an essential extension of our staff in communication back

regarding route pacing, rest stop closure timing, etc. **Must be an experienced cyclist.**

Motorcycle Marshall: Is dispatched to various "tricky" and high trafficked intersections throughout our route, maintaining the safety of our riders throughout their day. **Must provide own motorcycle and have a valid driver's license.**

Medical (Specialty): Assists at Rest Stops with all basic medical needs including icing sore muscles, minor scrapes and bruises, ace wraps, and more. **Must have medical license (EMT, MD, LPN, RN, PA, etc.)**

DESCRIPTION OF START/FINISH VOLUNTEER DUTIES:

Registration & Check-In: Check-In riders for both the 62 mile start, and 25 mile start. Distributes check-in packet that includes rider bib, bracelet, and participant SWAG!

Volunteer Check-In: Assists the Staff Volunteer Coordinator with checking in pre-assigned volunteers throughout the day.

Donations & Premiums Tent: Assists HSS Staff with receiving donations, and incentive distribution.

Info & Participant Services: Answers participant questions about the route, services, festival timing, and oversees lost and found.

Food & Beverage Tent: Assists the caterer with breakfast prior to Ride start, and lunch/beverage area post-event during the Finish Line Festival.

Bike Check: Oversees the "self-check" bike area in keeping it secure, mainly during Finish Line Festival.

Gear Check: Manages bag check for those participants wishing to keep their personals at the Festival site while on the road.

Crowd Control: Help manage venue flow before and after the ride. Includes corralling riders and managing queues at Start Line, welcoming and directing riders when they return from their ride, and assisting attendees with direction around the venue.
