Medical Assistance

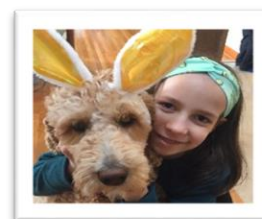

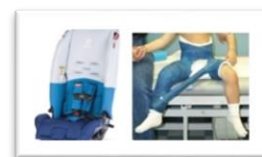
*Ayden's dad received gas vouchers so he could keep his job in Erie and still visit Ayden in the Neonatal ICU every few days.*
