REACH PROGRAM

“Richstone Educating, Assisting, Counseling, & Healing” is a comprehensive child abuse treatment and prevention program that provides services for the whole family:

- Counseling for individuals, groups, couples, and families
- Trauma Focused Therapy
- Parent Child Interactive Therapy (PCIT) for children ages 2-7 and their parents
- Parenting Classes
- Anger Management Classes
- Case Management

KIDS CLUB AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM

Is a year-round program providing homework help, tutoring, social skills development, character-building and enrichment activities six days a week for children in the 1st-8th grades.

COMMUNITY programs



RICHSTONE CARE-A-VAN

This customized mobile unit provides these services at select schools and community sites in Lawndale, Lennox and Wilmington:

- Parent Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) for children ages 2-7 and their parents
- Individual, group and family counseling
- Parenting classes
- Prevention education workshops

HOME VISITATIONS

The program provides parent education, family needs assessments, and case management to assist with follow-up support and referrals.

TRANSITIONAL LIVING

Is a residential program for young women, 18-24 years of age who have been emancipated from foster care and are in need of support.

SCHOOL programs



A.L.L. AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM

“Academic Lifelong Learning” provides daily homework help, learning opportunities and enrichment activities to students enrolled in the program at elementary and middle schools in the Hawthorne School District.

“JUNTOS” PROJECT

Provides individual, group and family counseling, as well as parenting classes and support at schools within the Lennox School District.

LAWNDALE SCHOOL READINESS

Home visitors provide resources and support to parents and their children (ages 0-5), living within the Lawndale community, to better prepare them for school and beyond.
