

Madison Rondinone **Juvenile Rheumatoid Arthritis** **Adult Honoree** **Team Rondo**

Madison Rondinone is 21 years old from Dover, New Hampshire. She has been officially diagnosed with juvenile rheumatoid arthritis (JRA) for 6 months, but symptomatic for about 10 years. Living with several different auto-immune conditions, her arthritis has been the most challenging. Madison's JRA has contributed to a rare degenerative joint disease, requiring total joint replacement surgery in her jaw. Madison works with the Arthritis Foundation to promote awareness and fundraise for other people like her. Madison is a full-time college student and employee. In her free time, she enjoys seeing friends and family, and being outdoors.
