I have been privileged to serve on the Board of Directors of Care for the Homeless for the past four years and look forward to my continuing service as the newly elected Board Chair. The mission of caring for homeless people is deeply important to me and I thank you for your devotion to our mission. The support good friends like you provide in so many forms makes the organization's work possible.

As I believe you know, our esteemed Executive Director, Bobby Watts, will be leaving CFH to become CEO of the National Health Care for the Homeless Council. I want to assure you that the Board's most important current objective is to ensure that, when Bobby departs, the right leadership is in place to meet the needs of staff members, clients, and our donors and funders. The Board recently engaged a search firm to assist us in recruiting an Interim Executive Director who will serve as a management leader to help CFH with its immediate needs. This will allow us the time and critical attention to the recruitment effort for the permanent Executive Director, which we anticipate will take from six to nine months after the interim ED is in place.


