TRAIL GAMES SCHEDULE

- Trail Games start Thursday night at the Rider Meeting
- Trail Games finish Saturday night after dinner

RULES OF ENGAGEMENT

- 9 Games - 4 "Home", 5 "Away"
- Each color group will compete against each other earn points
- Trail Games judged on different criteria and awarded points

POINT SYSTEM

- Groups will be awarded points based off points available for each game

1. PUZZLE RACE (HOME GAME)

When: Thursday, January 27 after the Rider Meeting

Description: All color groups will participate in putting together a winter themed puzzle. Points will be awarded based on time.

Maximum Points Earned: 10

2. GROUP PICTURES (HOME GAME)

When: Thursday, January 27 after the Rider Meeting

Description: Each color group will receive 10 points for participating in taking a group picture. Groups are encouraged to dress up in their color for this picture. Be as creative as possible as group pictures will be voted on by riders on Friday night before dinner.

Maximum Points Earned: 10

3. BEST OF GROUP PICTURES (HOME GAME)

When: Thursday, January 27 after the Rider Meeting

Description: Group pictures will be voted on by riders before dinner on Friday night through a text survey. Photos will be displayed in the banquet room prior to dinner. The color group voted Best Color Group Photo will receive max points. Each color group will receive one vote each (including Camo). Color groups cannot vote for their own photo..

Maximum Points Earned: 10

4. TURKEY BOWLING (AWAY GAME)

When: Lunch on Friday, January 28

Description: Groups will nominate three (3) people to participate in Turkey Bowling. Each chosen member of the team will take one shot at rolling a frozen turkey at 10 bowling pins.

Maximum Points Earned: 30

5. TEAM CHALLENGE (HOME GAME)

When: Friday, January 28 after dinner

Description: Groups will be responsible for building a specified structure using marshmallows and noodles in a set amount of time. No further details will be given prior to building.

Maximum Points Earned: 30

6. WHERE IN WISCONSIN IS J.HOLTMAN SAN DIEGO? (AWAY GAME)

When: Lunch on Saturday, January 29

Description: Photo and descriptive hints will be given to groups during lunch of five (5) notable landmarks in the "North Woods." Points will be awarded to groups based on most correct guesses. Groups will submit their guesses before the end of lunch on Saturday.

Maximum Points Earned: 25

7. CORNHOLE (AWAY GAME)

When: Lunch on Saturday, January 29

Description: Groups will nominate two (2) people to participate in cornhole. Each chosen member of the team will take turns tossing three (3) bean bags onto a cornhole board. Each bag that makes it in the hole will be awarded three (3) points, bags on the board will be awarded one (1) point each.

Maximum Points Earned: 18

8. SNOWMAN BUILDING CONTEST (AWAY GAME)

When: Throughout the weekend, ending on Saturday, January 29 at 5 pm

Description: Groups will be given the opportunity to build a snowman anytime throughout the weekend. Snowmen will be judged on a series of criteria.
