Where and when is the Walk?

Saturday, May 20th at Sam Houston Park (1000 Bagby St, Houston, TX 77002)

- 12:00 PM Walk Ends

Where do we park?

This year, parking for NAMIWalks Greater Houston is offered at a reduced rate through our friends at **SP+ parking!** Parking is **\$10** (credit card only) and the SP+ garage is located at **300 Clay St., Houston, Texas 77002**.

Additional SP+ parking garages can be found near Sam Houston Park but are subject to normal weekend rates.

Registration

I registered online, do I need to check-in at the walk?

Yes! All participants must check-in on Walk Day.

I'm a Team Captain, can I check in my whole team?

No, each participant needs to check themselves in and pick up their wristband themselves.

Do I need to register to walk?

Yes! Everyone walking must register (but don't worry, it's FREE!).

We encourage you to register **ONLINE now**.

Companies, organizations and families are encouraged to organize teams of walkers made up of employees, organization members, relatives and friends to take part in the Walk.

Registration forms will be available on Walk Day and our volunteers will help get you registered quickly so you can enjoy the event!

What if I need help registering for the walk on walkday?


NAMIWalk volunteers will be on-site helping those in need of extra assistance to register for the event.

The Walk

What is the Walk route and how far is it?

The NAMIWalks Greater Houston starting/finish line is at the eastern entrance to Sam Houston Park (near the fountain) on Lamar street. From here participants will walk towards and down Allen Pkwy, to around Waugh Dr. and back. The approximate total distance is 5 km or 3.1 miles.



Can I run instead of walk?

We are historically a non-competitive 5k walk, so the majority of people will be walkers. If you really want to run though- go for it! If you are running, please run off to the side and be considerate of our walkers!

I'm not sure that I/someone I am walking with can finish a 5k, but I/we still want to walk. What can I do?

We've got you covered! Our course is a relatively flat, paved road with only a few areas of elevation changes and/or hills. **The great news is - you can turn around as soon or as late as you'd like!** And if you are unable or uninterested in walking, please still join us! There are plenty of other festivities starting at 7:30 am that you can enjoy.

Are strollers allowed?

Yes! Strollers and wagons are allowed. We are family-friendly and hope to see lots of smiling youngsters on May 20th!

Are dogs allowed?

Yes! Leashed, well-behaved dogs are allowed. Please remember to bring the little baggies to clean up after your pet and dispose of the waste in a proper receptacle.

Although we love dogs at NAMIWalks, please note that there will be approximately 2,500 people in attendance at the event. If your dog is not child-friendly, or is not able to handle moderate noise/crowds/other dogs, please consider whether bringing your pup to this event is the right choice.*

Should I bring food?

That's up to you! We'll have some snack bars and water. The event is over by 12 pm so you can either plan on staying in the park and having a picnic - or visit one of the great local restaurants nearby for lunch with your friends/families/teams!

Donations

Can I donate offline or send in my check/cash donations prior to the Walk?
