

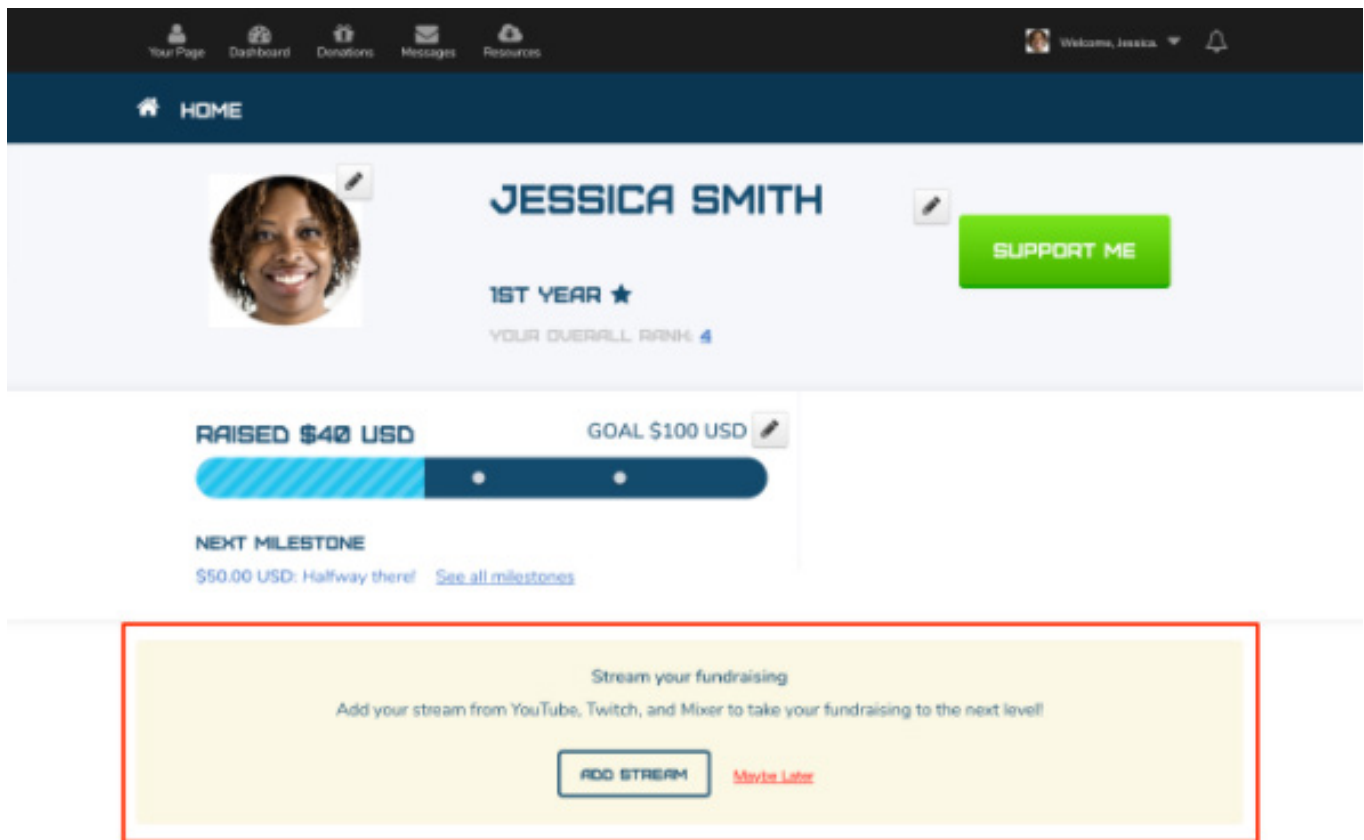
# Live Stream Your SkyRise Participation

When Live Fundraising™ is enabled, fundraisers can easily add a stream to their personal fundraising page right after they register. They choose their streaming service (YouTube or Twitch, add in their username, and add a stream to their fundraising page.

Once a fundraiser connects to Live Fundraising, donors visiting the fundraising page will see the stream at the top of the fundraising page. They can donate to the fundraiser without leaving the fundraising page or the stream.

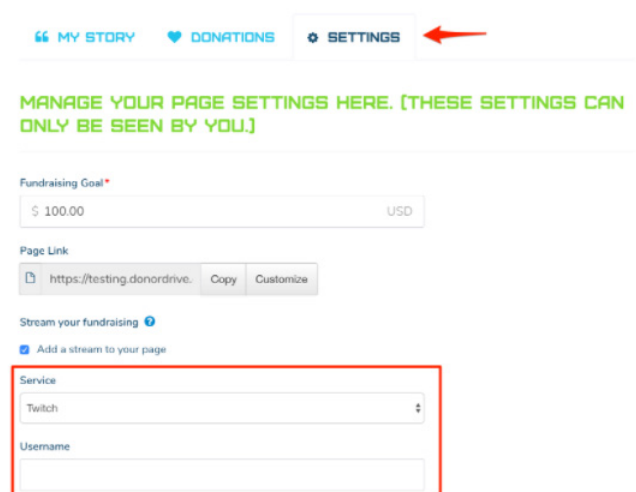
## Live Fundraising™ for Fundraisers

After a participant or personal campaign creator registers, they will have the option of adding their stream:



A fundraiser can always opt to add their stream at a later date. To add a stream after selecting Maybe Later, a participant can:

1. Log in to their Fundraising Portal.
2. Click Your Page.
3. Click Settings.
4. Click Add a Stream and select the streaming service of choice.
5. Enter their Username and click Save Changes.



## Live Fundraisers for Donors

When a fundraiser adds their stream to their DonorDrive fundraising page, donors can view the stream and donate towards the fundraiser's goal. A donor can join the chat, if the streaming service offers one, and can keep track of the fundraiser's progress in their activity feed. The activity feed appears directly below a fundraiser's stream and updates as a fundraiser receives donations and badges:
