Sleep Out FAQ

Q: What if I don't want to spend the night, and just come for the program?

A: That is absolutely ok! This event is designed to accommodate all families and abilities. If you would like to just stay for the program and music, show up closer to 7 p.m.!

Q: Will there be tents and chairs available?

A: No, bring your own tents and chairs.

Q: Will alcohol be served?

A: No. Per municipality code, alcohol is not permitted.

Q: Are proof of vaccination or masks required?

A: No. This is an outdoor event. However if you would like to wear a mask you are welcome to.

Q: Are pets allowed?

A: No. We love your pets! But sometimes pets don't love each other. Please leave them at home.

Q: Can I grill out?

A: Absolutely! Just be responsible. Coals have to be properly disposed of and propane tanks cannot be on while not in use.
