Cheering Station #1

Between Quick Stop A and Rest Stop 1
In front of Marathon Sports on Boylston St.
Mile 2.6

Peak Viewing Times: 8:30pm-9:30pm

Parking - Local garages; street parking very limited.
Public transportation - Copley Square Station on the Green Line.

Cheering Station #2

Between Rest Stop 1 and Quick Stop B
Corner of Essex St. and Surface Rd, at the end of the Chinese Garden park.

Mile 4.1

Peak Viewing Times: 9:00pm-11:00pm

Parking - There are parking garages in the area.
Public transportation - South Station on the Red Line.

Cheering Station #3

Between Rest Stop 1 and Quick Stop B
Corner of Summer Street and Pumphouse Road
Mile 5.2

Peak Viewing Times: 9:30pm-11:30pm

In the park area with the picnic tables.
Parking - Local garages and lots.
No public transportation.

Cheering Station #4

Between Quick Stop B and Midnight Snack
Aprx. 1880 William J Day Blvd, on the harbor side of the street.
Mile 7.4

Peak Viewing Times: 10:00pm-12:00am

Located opposite the Francis Murphy skating rink.
Parking - On Day Blvd. No public transportation.

Cheering Station #5

Between Midnight Snack and Quick Stop C
Corner Pier 4 Blvd and Seaport Blvd
Mile 10.7

Peak Viewing Times: 11:00pm-1:30am

Located at the corner in front of Ocean Prime.
Parking - Garages or meters on the street.
Public transportation - Silver line, either Courthouse or World Trade Center Stations.

Cheering Station #6

Between Quick Stop C and Rest Stop 2
Corner of Court Street and Tremont Street; in front of Bank of America.

Mile 12.1

Peak Viewing Times: 12:00am - 2:45am

Parking - Local garages.
Public transportation - Govt Center Station on the Green Line.

Cheering Station #7

Between Rest Stop 2 and Closing
Grassy area at the corner of Beacon Street and Charlesgate East

Mile 14.3

Peak Viewing Times: 1:00am-3:30am

Parking - Neighborhood street parking.
Public transportation - Kenmore Square on the Green Line, and then walking to location.
*Please cheer quietly in this residential neighborhood.

PLEASE NOTE: Public Transportation in Boston stops running at 12:30am/1:00am, depending on the location. Please plan your trips accordingly.
