

Frequently Asked Questions—Registration

Is there a registration fee to participate?

Yes. The fee for walkers and runners (age 13 and older) is \$40 for adults and Children (12 and under) is \$15.

Can I register on the day of the event?

Yes, but we strongly recommend you pre-register before the event to make sure you have all the advance information and materials you need. Also, this gives you time to fundraise before the event. If you register at packet pick-up or the day of, the cost is \$45 for adults (age 13 and older) and \$15 for children (12 and under).

Can someone walk without being registered?

Everyone who walks must be registered and have signed the waiver release form.

Why is there a \$40 fee for adult registrants (13 and older) and a \$15 fee for children (12 and under)?

The fees help The UC Brain Tumor Center cover the cost of hosting Walk Ahead for a Brain Tumor Cure 5K Walk/Run and ensure that the event is safe and enjoyable for everyone.

Teams and Team Captains

Why do people form teams?

Teams are often formed to walk in honor or in memory of a friend or family member. For corporations, it's a great way to build morale and develop camaraderie outside the office while supporting a great cause. Many UC Health and University of Cincinnati departments choose to form teams.

How do I form a team?

Team captains can create a team during the registration process. When registering, they will create the team name and set a team fundraising goal.

How will my team members register?

Once the team captain has registered the team, team members can register online by clicking on the Join a Team option on the Registration page or by searching for the team name.

What if I register before my team captain, can I join their team? Can I join a team after I've completed the registration process?

Why must we have a team captain?

We need to have one designated person in the group with whom The Brain Tumor Center can communicate.

What are the responsibilities of a Team Captain?

Team Captains recruit participants to join their team and serve as the "go to" communication person between the UC Brain Tumor Center and the team.
