Laurie Hoppenjans, President of the Wyoming School Foundation, announced the Scholarship Awards for thirteen graduating seniors from the Class of 2019.

The scholarship awards, totaling over \$25,000, were funded by generous supporters of our students and schools through the Wyoming School Foundation.

The **Dorothy F. Mantel Scholarship** is awarded to a senior who, in addition to outstanding academic performance, has cared about the school and school environment as evidenced by interest and contributions that have made a positive difference in school. The recipient of this scholarship award is **Lydia Hock**, who plans to attend Xavier University.

The **Fred S. Dewey Scholarship**, named in memory of Fred S. Dewey and his service to his country during WWII, recognizes a female and male senior who are considered the top multi-sport athletes in the class, are dedicated to their sport, demonstrate exemplary character and leadership as a student and athlete, and demonstrate academic achievement and service to their community. The recipients of this scholarship award are **Joey Edmonds**, who plans to attend the University of Findlay, and **Elly McCullumsmith**, who plans to attend the Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology.

The **Go the Distance Scholarship** is awarded to a senior male and female who participated in the WHS Cross Country program, and who best exemplify the spirit of the sport and the life lessons it teaches. The recipients of this scholarship award are **Riley Bahr**, who plans to attend Florida State University, and **Jack Schwartz**, who plans to attend Indiana University.

The **Kindness Matters Scholarship** was established in loving memory of Richard Beck, a high school senior who died suddenly in a car accident on May 16, 2010. This scholarship is awarded to a student who has been a shining example of kindness and caring to others. The recipient of this scholarship award is **Meliah Hodges**. Meliah plans to attend The Ohio State University.

The **Lynn Y. S. Lin Family Scholarship** recognizes students in good standing who have achieved benchmark cumulative GPA, and are pursuing secondary education. The recipients of this scholarship award are **Ky'leese Haysbert**, who plans to attend the University of Kentucky, **Campbell Burke**, who plans to attend Trinity University in Texas, and **Savannah Kellner**, who plans to attend the University of Michigan.
